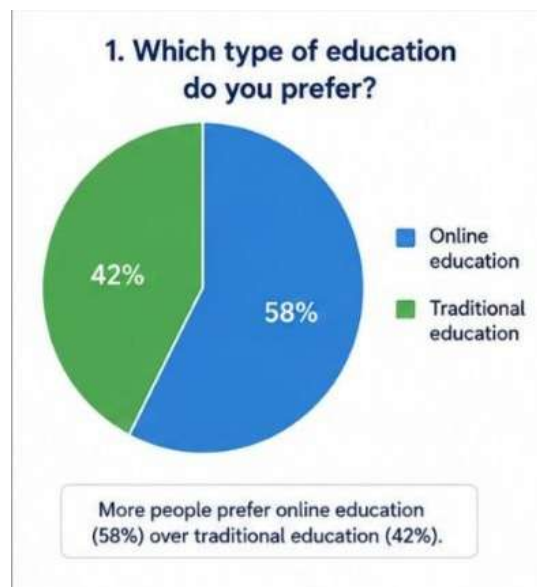
not have to be in a specific location. You can also have video chats with your teachers and classmates.

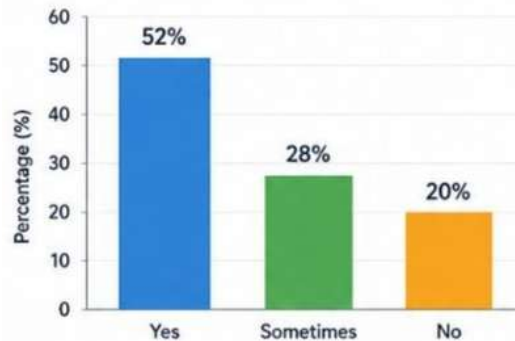

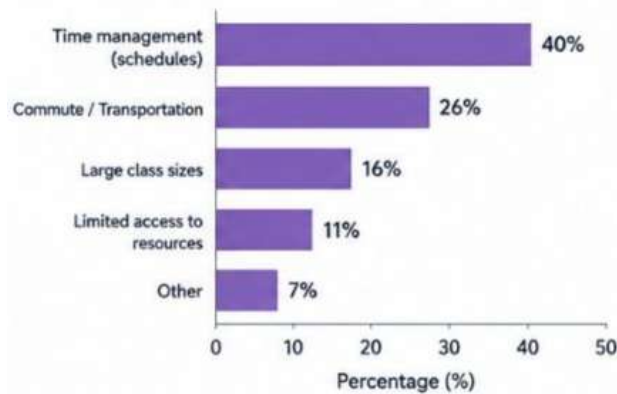


2. Are there technical problems in your area for studying online?

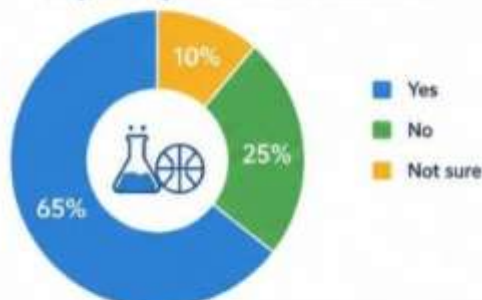


More than half of respondents face technical problems in their area.

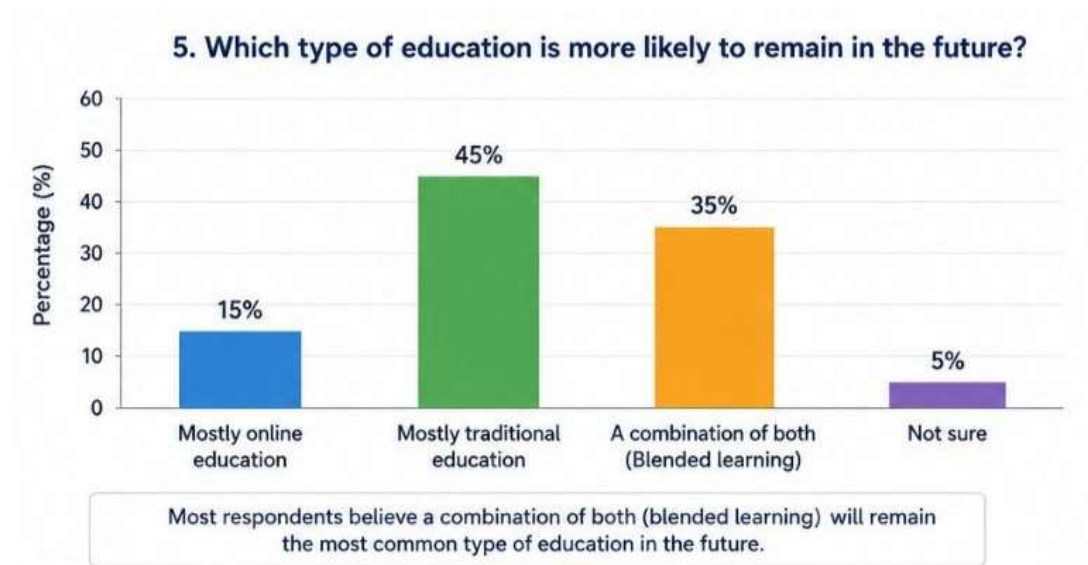
3. What are the biggest difficulties you face in traditional education?
